The Bread of the Eucharist. At the Last Supper, Jesus told his disciples, "Do this in memory of me" (Luke 22:19). This is precisely what we do every time we celebrate the Mass. We remember Jesus and what he has done for us. We weren't present at the Last Supper, but because of the grace of the sacrament and the power of the Holy Spirit, we can still feel as if we were there. We can still picture ourselves with the disciples hearing Jesus say, "This is my body. . . . This is my blood." And remembering this moment of grace can help us find the peace and security: *Today, Jesus is giving me himself as Living Bread, and he will give himself to me tomorrow—for the rest of my life.* In that quiet time just before you receive Communion, fix your imagination on the historical Jesus.
