GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

As many people will be aware, GDPR was introduced as new legislation in Europe last May. It requires that all bodies who hold data comply with high standards of storage, privacy and confidentiality. Accordingly Edgeworthstown Parish is obliged to maintain records to show that it is compliant. It is required that all parish volunteers sign a Consent Form to allow the parish to hold your name, address, phone number etc on file. Consent Forms are available near the Sacristy.
