Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

One of the more profound and unsearchable mysteries of Christianity is the mystery of the Trinity. It is a mystery which was revealed over time, in the pages of the Hebrew Scriptures which we sometimes call the Old Testament and in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth. It is Christianity's answer to the question: who is God? In the New Testament. There is evidence that first two and then three persons were proclaimed as being part of God. This belief was given fuller elaboration in the following centuries. God is there yet God is one.
