#### FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI:

Today's feast has its origins as far back as 1264, Pope Urban at the behest of St Thomas Aquinas the great mind of the church at the time as is still to this day a leading light in theology, they wished to create a feast whose focus was solely on the Holy eucharist. In canon law it is one of the 5 days in which a bishop can not be absent from his diocese without grave reason. The feast is celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday or on the following Sunday as we do here in Ireland for the past 40 years or so.
