CATHOLIC WOMEN'S CONFERENCES.

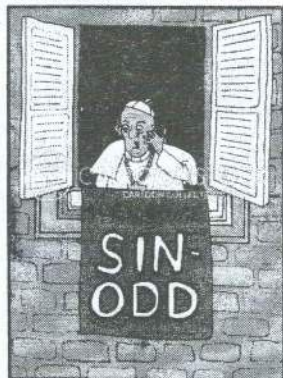
