Pope Francis has proclaimed 2025 to be the Ordinary Jubilee or Holy Year 2025. The Bull of Indicition was given at St John's Latern Basilica on the solemnity of the Ascension. Pope Francis writes "For all of us, may the Jubilee year be an opportunity to be renewed in Hope. God's word helps us find reasons for that hope. Taking it as our guide, let us return to the message that the Apostle Paul wished to communicate to the Christians of Rome as he wrote " Hope does not disappoint", hope is the central message of the coming Jubilee that, in accordance with an ancient tradition, the Pope proclaims every 25 years. The Holy door will be opened in St Peters Rome through which millions of pilgrims will pass through. The Jubilee Year 25 will commence on Christmas Eve until 6th Jan 2026...

A LITTLE THEOLOGY "APPARITIONS"

The church teaches that so-called public revelations ended within the death of the last Apostles, the church does not require that catholics believe in any apparition not found in scripture. Even so, the church has endorsed certain post-scripture appearances that has involved Mary and other heavenly beings as being worthy of belief. An apparition is a charismatic gift of God for some greater purpose of His than the benefit of the one receiving it. It says nothing necessary about the sanctity of the recipient. Only 13 apparitions have being given approval by the church, these include Lourdes, Knock, Fatima, Guadalupe and Siluva.
