#### A LITTLE THEOLOGY. FORGIVENESS

Are we required to forgive someone when they are not sorry? At first we will say yes, as this seems to be the christian thing to do, but when we read scripture we see God only forgives those who repent of their sins, the Lord will not forgive those who have not asked for forgiveness.. this seems clear as clear can be. So we are not asked to go beyond God's mercy. We have to distinguish between our call to forgive those who are sorry and our call to love everyone without exception, St Thomas Aquinas tells us "love is willing the good of the others selflessly" Jesus tells us "love your enemies" He said nothing about liking them, we will always have enemies of one kind or another, the call is to go beyond our human inclination to condemn then and by the grace of God but on the divine mind and be free from anger.
