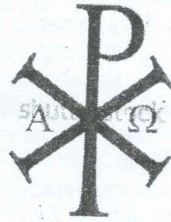

Saintly wisdom: Faith & Love.

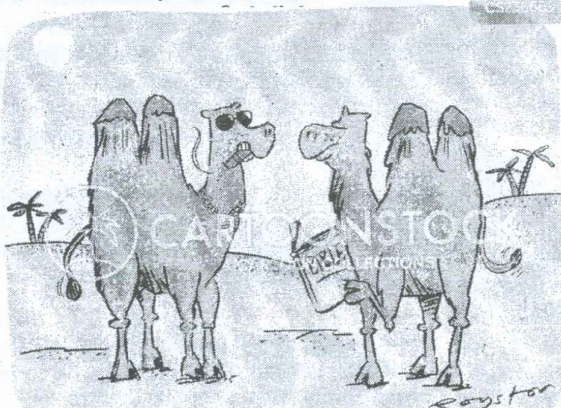

A little theology (salvation outside the church)

The church teaches that salvation comes from Jesus Christ and His church., but it also acknowledges that individuals can be saved even without explicit membership in the visible holy catholic church, if they are ignorant of the Gospel through no fault of their own. The traditional teaching 'extra ecclesiam nulla salus' (outside the church there is no salvation) is to understood to mean that all salvation comes from Christ through His body, the church, but that God can lead those ignorant of the Gospel to salvation. The church emphasizes that God is merciful and desires the salvation of all people. He can lead those without knowledge of the church to salvation.

Did you know!

The church has more diplomatic relations than any other nation in the world, The word Catholic was first used by Ignatius of Antioch in around 110 AD. The devil's advocate is a real position in the church they are appointed by the cause of saints to argue why a person should not be declared a saint, Brazil has more catholics than Italy, France and Poland combined, 127 million, it is followed by Mexico with 96 million and then the Philippines 76 million.
