Give us water! The steamship replied, 'Lower your buckets where you are.' The captain was furious at this cavalier response but called out again, 'Please, give us water.' But the steamer gave the same reply, 'Lower your buckets where you are! And with that they sailed away! The captain was beside himself with anger and despair, and he went below. But a little later, when no one was looking, a yeoman lowered a bucket into the sea and then tasted what be brought up: It was perfectly sweet, fresh water!
