A permanent deacon is required to study for 3 years, and be married, and once formation is completed they are ordained, they serve the local church as teachers, preachers, they can marry and baptise, preside over funerals. The can not anoint the sick, hear confession of offer mass, so please pray for these two men who please God ordained to serve this diocese.
