THEOLOGY OF LENT.

Lent is the 40-day liturgical season of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, running from Ash Wednesday to Holy Thursday, to be observed by Christians in preparation for the Easter mysteries. It mirrors Jesus' 40 days in the desert, focusing on repentance, spiritual discipline and a deeper conversion, key requirements include fasting and abstinence. The 3 pillars of Lent are a more intense focus on prayer through scripture, reflection & seeking the Lord. Fasting and practising self-denial teaches us to be more detached from world pleasure and so grow closer to God in almsgiving. We share both our resources, gifts and time so that those in need may improve their lot.
