### **Sunday Scriptures - First Reading**

God revealed himself to Moses on Mount Sinai as a God of tenderness and compassion. Moses begged God to accompany his stubborn people on their journey to the Promised Land.

**Second Reading** - This is the conclusion of St Paul's second letter to the Christians at Corinth. We sometimes use it as a greeting at the start of Mass.

**Gospel** - This passage has a most consoling message. God the Father sent his Son to us, not to condemn us, but to save us.

**SUNDAY REFLECTION** - The Trinity is not first of all a puzzle, which in principle could be solved, but rather a mystery, a relationship which is first of all lived, never exhausted and only inadequately spoken of in words. This is true of any of the significant relationships in our lives and true therefore all the more so of God. Within the mystery of that relationship, we recognize God, from whom we come, in whom we live and move
